Polly Trautweiler and Terry England will take you to the renowned Kitzbuhel ski area which ranks among the most popular in the world. We'll fly roundtrip to Munich via Delta. We will enjoy 7 nights accommodations at the 4 star Kaiserhof Hotel (<http://www.hotel-kaiserhof.at>) including breakfast and dinner daily. Recently expanded and restored, it is located directly next to the base station of the Hahnenkamm cable car. The hotel is a spa with steam baths, saunas, indoor pool, fitness room, tanning solarium and infrared cabin. Revitalized "Grander" water flows inside the hotel and in the pools. Shopaholics will love Kitzbuhel with its haute couture boutiques, handcraft shops, clothing, shoes, jewelry and antiques. The city is blessed with an exquisite walled center, divided into two areas – the Vorderstadt and the Hinterstadt. Narrow cobbled streets, gabled houses with their frescos, archways and color washed facades, as well as the bells of the nearby 14th Century St. Andreas church paint a picturesque scene.

In addition to the famous Streif, the world's most difficult downhill run, the Alps offer 60 groomed, avalanche safe runs for all ability levels with quaint mountain huts to take a break. There are 55 lifts and gondolas and the area includes 7 villages. The base is at 2493 ft and the summit at 6545 ft. There is snowmaking if needed servicing 40% beginner, 45% intermediate and 15% advanced runs with the longest run being 4 miles. The main Ski Safari route begins at the cable car next to the hotel and returns from Pass Thurn, after passing thru Wurzhöhe and the Resterhöhe. The Kitzbuheler Horn, or so called sunny side of Kitzbuhel, is on the opposite side of the valley and has some excellent cruising runs.



Preceding our week in Kitzbuhel, we'll travel by motor coach from Munich to Zell-Am-Ziller in the Ziller Valley for 4 nights at the well known Hotel Theresa with breakfast, lunch and a 5 course dinner included daily (www.THERESA.at). Breakfast includes an extensive buffet and health corner. Light wellness buffet of soups, salads and deserts for lunch and a 5 course menu for dinner with soft drinks, tea, fruit and mineral water free all day. This is a fantastic full service spa hotel with indoor and outdoor pools, whirlpool, gym, panorama brine pool, multiple saunas, and a beauty lounge which has massages, facials, Turkish baths and all the spa services found in your most exclusive hotels. The mountain view quiet room tops all others for the perfect place to relax. For those that want to ski, the nearby Hintertux glacier is a 15 minute train ride departing right out the front door of the hotel, as well as other nearby ski mountains. Hiking trails surround the valley and nearby towns offer wonderful shopping experiences for all, again only a short train ride away. Rooms are appointed in traditional Tyrolean theme with robes and slippers provided for all guests to wear while walking to any of the spa services.

Passports are required for travel to Austria, and they must be valid for 6 months following the tour dates. If you need a new or renewal passport, apply early as there may be delays.
