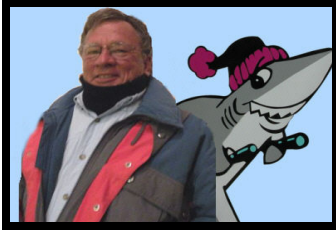

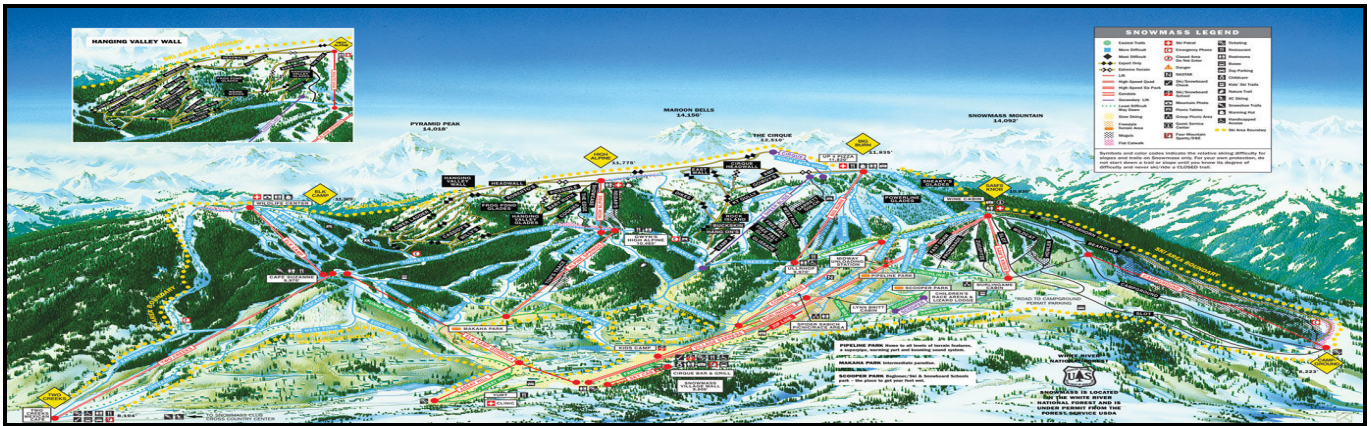

Payment: Deposit and balance of trip costs can be paid by check or with a major credit card (3% will be added for CC). You will be billed later for final payment. At that time you will be able to order lift tickets, reserve ski-rentals, and select optional activities. *TRIP PRICES ARE SUBJECT TO ANY NEW TAXES, FUEL SURCHARGES OR FEES IMPOSED BY EITHER THE GOVERNMENT, THE AIRPORT, AIRLINES OR ANY AGENCIES INVOLVED.*
